10. St. John's Church. Rev. Wm. D. Morgan, Rector; York Road, opp. Gilmor Lane. First service held November 1843. Church was incorporated July 10, 1844. Corner Stone Laid April 22, 1847, by Rt Rev. Wm. R. Wittingham, Bishop of Maryland. Church destroyed by fire, May 15, 1858

11. Oak Lawn. Residence of Late Dr. James Wilson. Gilmore Lane and Barclay Street

14. Gotleib Engel. House over 100 Years Old. Removed 1895 East side York Road, 200 feet North of Chestnut Hill Avenue

16. New Baptist Church. 1873. Cor. Barclay and 31st Streets. Rev. John Berg, Pastor.

17. Residence Arthur H. Jackson, Dr. H. T. Prentis and Dr. Henry Whittle. Gorsuch Avenue, near Tinges Lane.

26. Waverly Hall, 1872. Nome Progressive Castle No. 20; and Baltimore Temple No. 1 Knights and Ladie's Gold Eagle. York Road and 31st Street.

- 28. Huntingdon. Built in 1836 by the late James Wilson. Northwest of Barclay and 31st Streets.**
- 29. Home Late Ex-Mayor Samuel Brady. Now Public School Annex. Formerly occupied by Lieut. Col. James Biays, Great-grandfather of Hon. James Barry Mahool. Gilmor Lane and 29th Street.**
- 30. Lawrence Leight, 1845. Corner York Road and Gilmor Lane.**
- 31. Home David Mumma, Andrew Heavey, Peter Sauerwein, Wm. C. Bordley. Old York Road and Tinges Lane.**
- 32. Residence David Mumma, Wm. C. Bordley. Formerly York Road and Friendship Lane. Now Friendship Lane East York Road.**
